Principles and Practice of Aviation Medicine, Williams & Wilkins (1939) Aerospace medicine, Williams... Residency (medicine) [x]completion of such training is a requirement in order to obtain an unrestricted license to practice medicine, and in particular a license to practice a chosen... Internal medicine [x]back to the incorporation of scientific principles into medical practice in the 1800s, while family medicine emerged as part of the primary care movement... Physician (redirect from Doctor (medicine)) [x]who practices medicine, which is concerned with promoting, maintaining or restoring health through the study, diagnosis, prognosis and treatment of disease... Military medicine [x]machines and equipment such as submarines, tanks, helicopters and airplanes. Undersea and aviation medicine can be understood as subspecialties of military... Doctor of Medicine [x]physicians and surgeons offered by medical schools in the United States. According to Harrison's Principles of Internal Medicine, "the training, practice, credentialing... Reverse shoulder replacement [x]as the "Grammont Principles", which were a set of rules that explained why his prosthesis was effective and why other reverse ball and socket designs failed... Privacy policy (redirect from Criticism of privacy policies) [x]Human Services, which in 1973 drafted a code of principles called the Fair Information Practices. The work of the advisory committee led to the Privacy Act... Space medicine [x]term "space medicine" in 1948 and was the first and only Professor of Space Medicine at the School of Aviation Medicine (SAM) at Randolph Air Force Base... Patient safety (category Evidence-based practices) [x]marketing Medical ethics – System of moral principles of the practice of medicine Medical error – Preventable adverse effect of medical care Medical identification... Physician assistant (redirect from Master of Physician Assistant Studies) [x]administration and other clinical environments. PAs may practice in primary care or Health Sciences specialties, including emergency medicine, surgery and cardiology... Engineering (redirect from Engineering (practice)) [x]is the practice of using natural science, mathematics, and the engineering design process to solve technical problems, increase efficiency and productivity...
